What to do: Base yourself in the riverside city of Siem Reap, making sure you explore the 12th-century Angkor Wat temple. For a few days of beach time, head to the sleepy

seaside town of Kampot before trekking in nearby Bokor National Park and spotting dolphins in northern Mekong.

Where to stay: La Résidence d'Angkor Hotel (www.residencedangkor.com) is an intimate, luxurious hotel set within a leafy walled garden in Siem Reap's lush riverside gardens (pictured). Traditional both in structure and decor, each of the 55 rooms are exquisitely decked out in bamboo and natural textiles, while the impressive new spa is ideal for couples in need of some serious post-wedding pampering.
